(1) IB Credit is only awarded for High Level (HL) exams, never for Standard Level (SL). If granted students cannot earn credit for the same subject matter while at Tandon in any combination of AP, IB, and/or other international exams.

(2) IB credit in chemistry can only be used as a science elective, will not count toward any majors or minors in BMS or CBE, and cannot serve as a co- or prereq for any course in the CBE department.

(3) IB HL 6, 7 in any foreign language may be used as a free elective depending on the major. Check with your academic advisor to find out.
