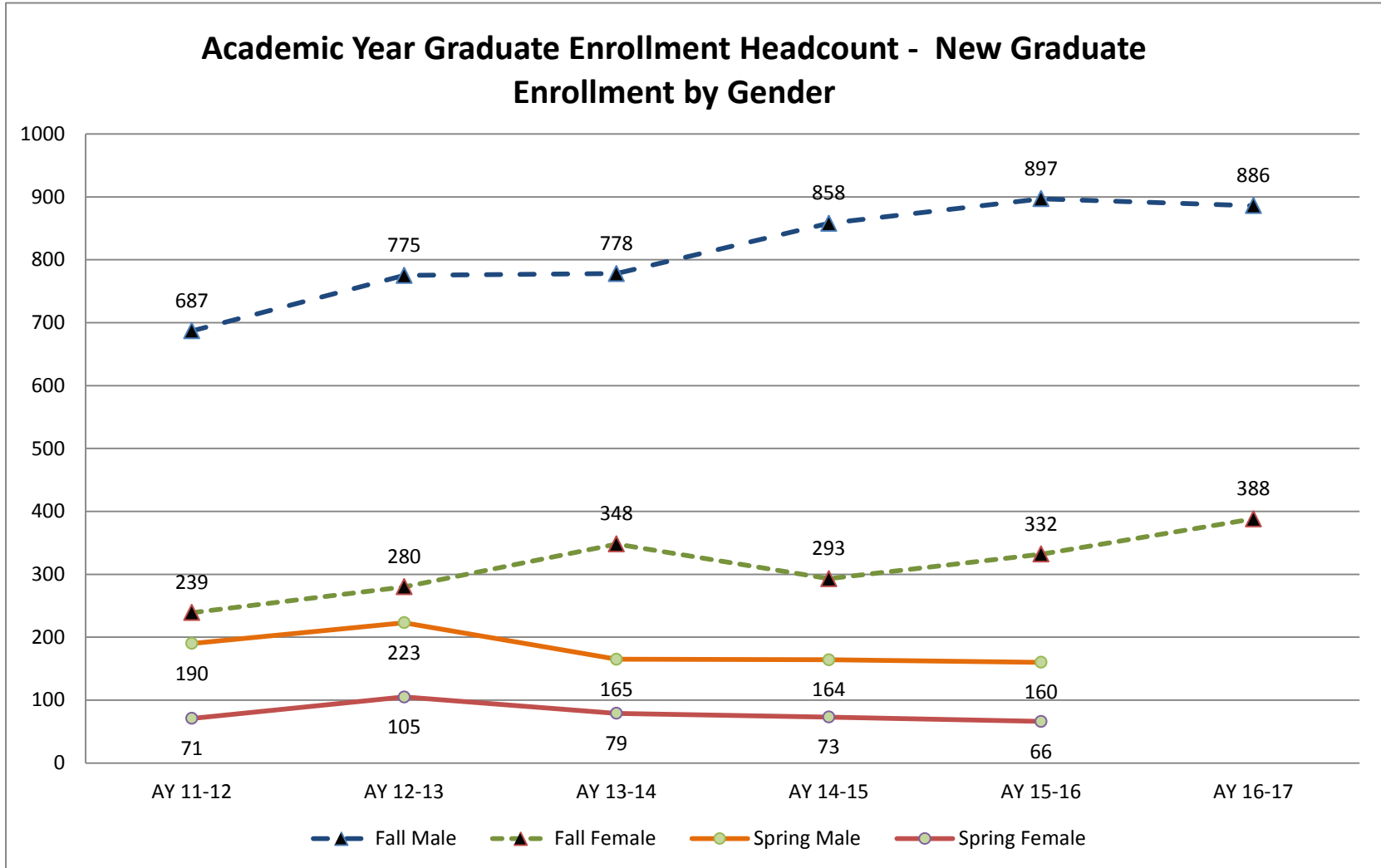


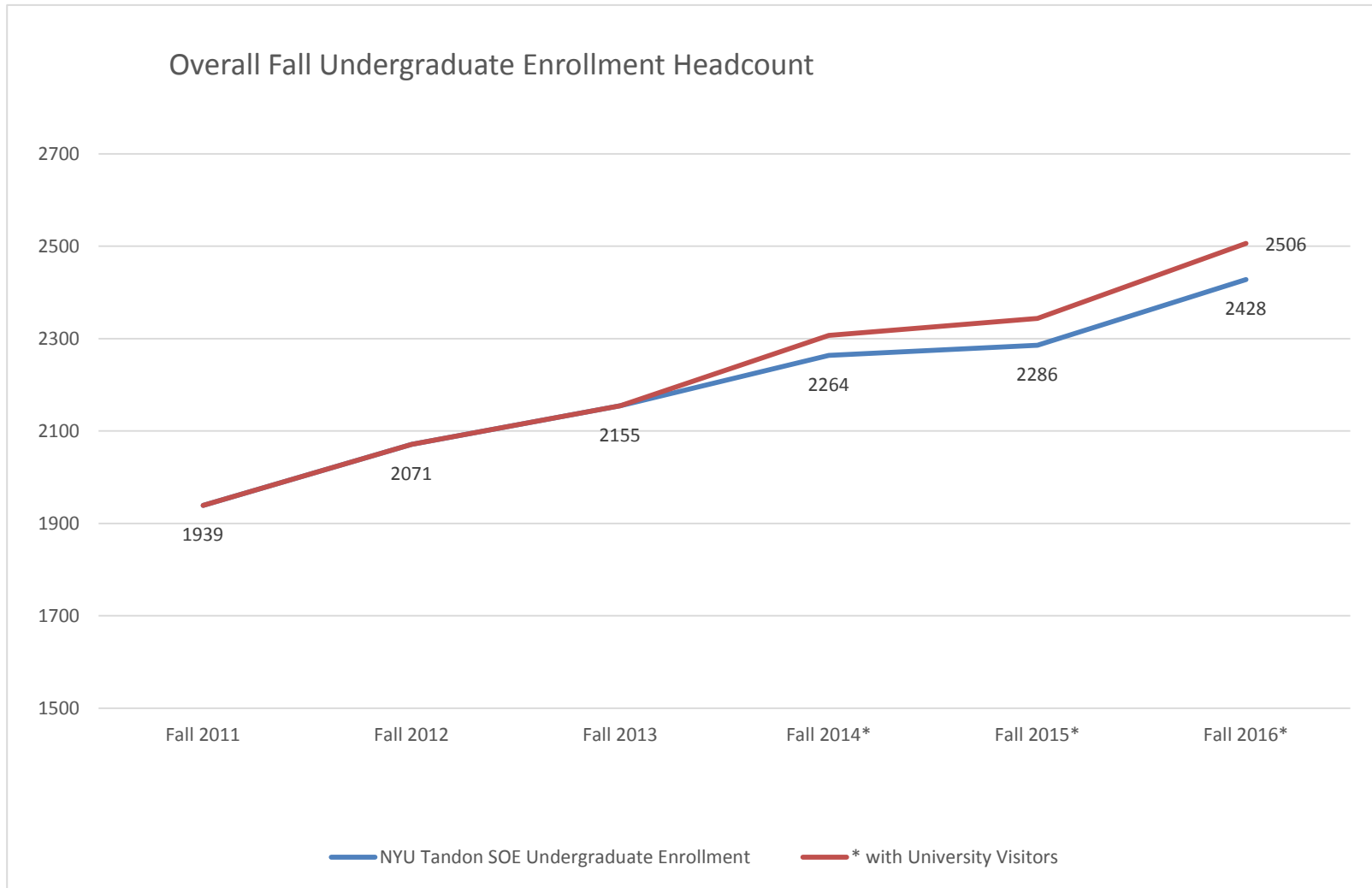




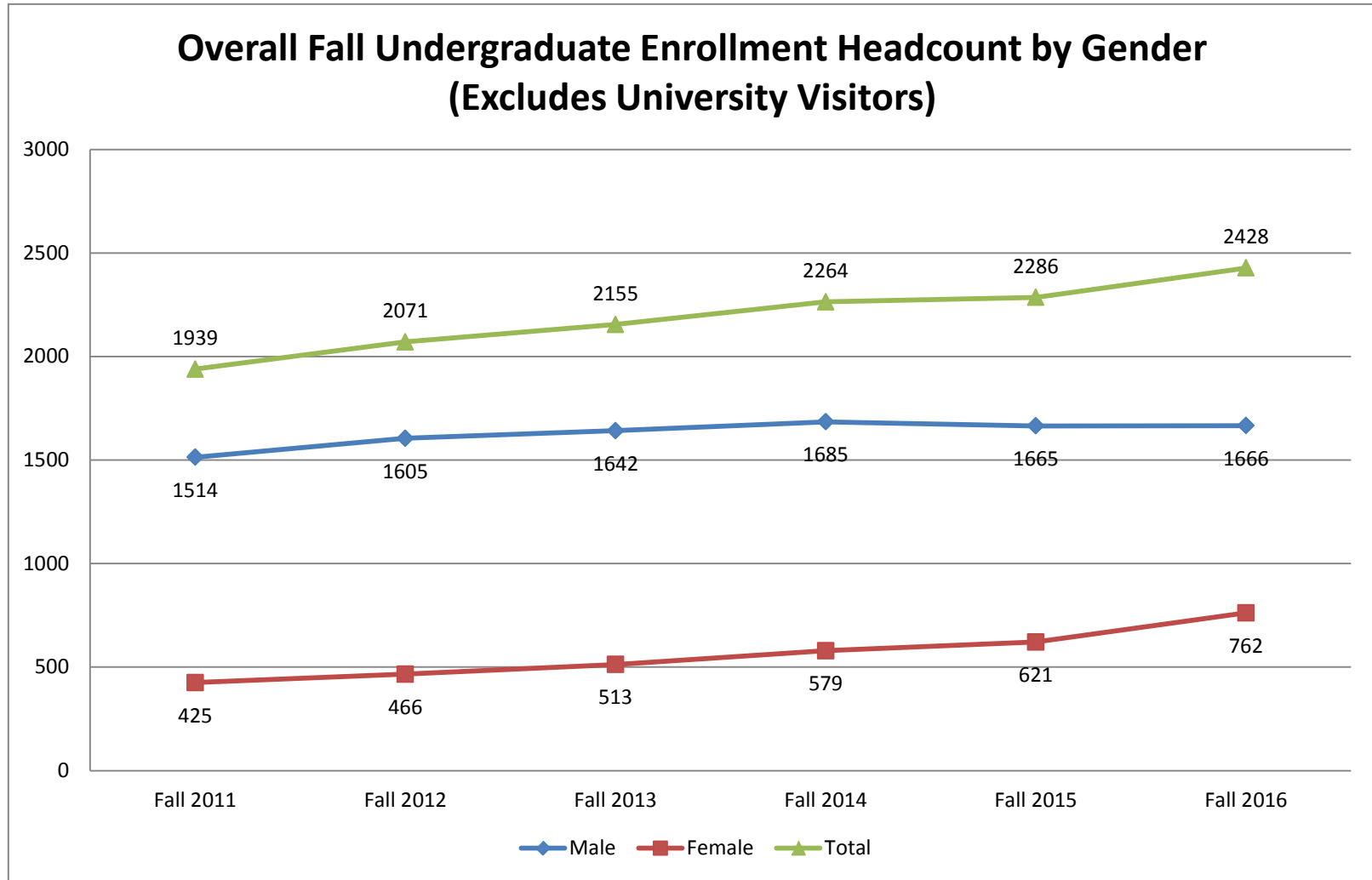
Academic Year Graduate Enrollment Headcount - New Graduate Enrollment







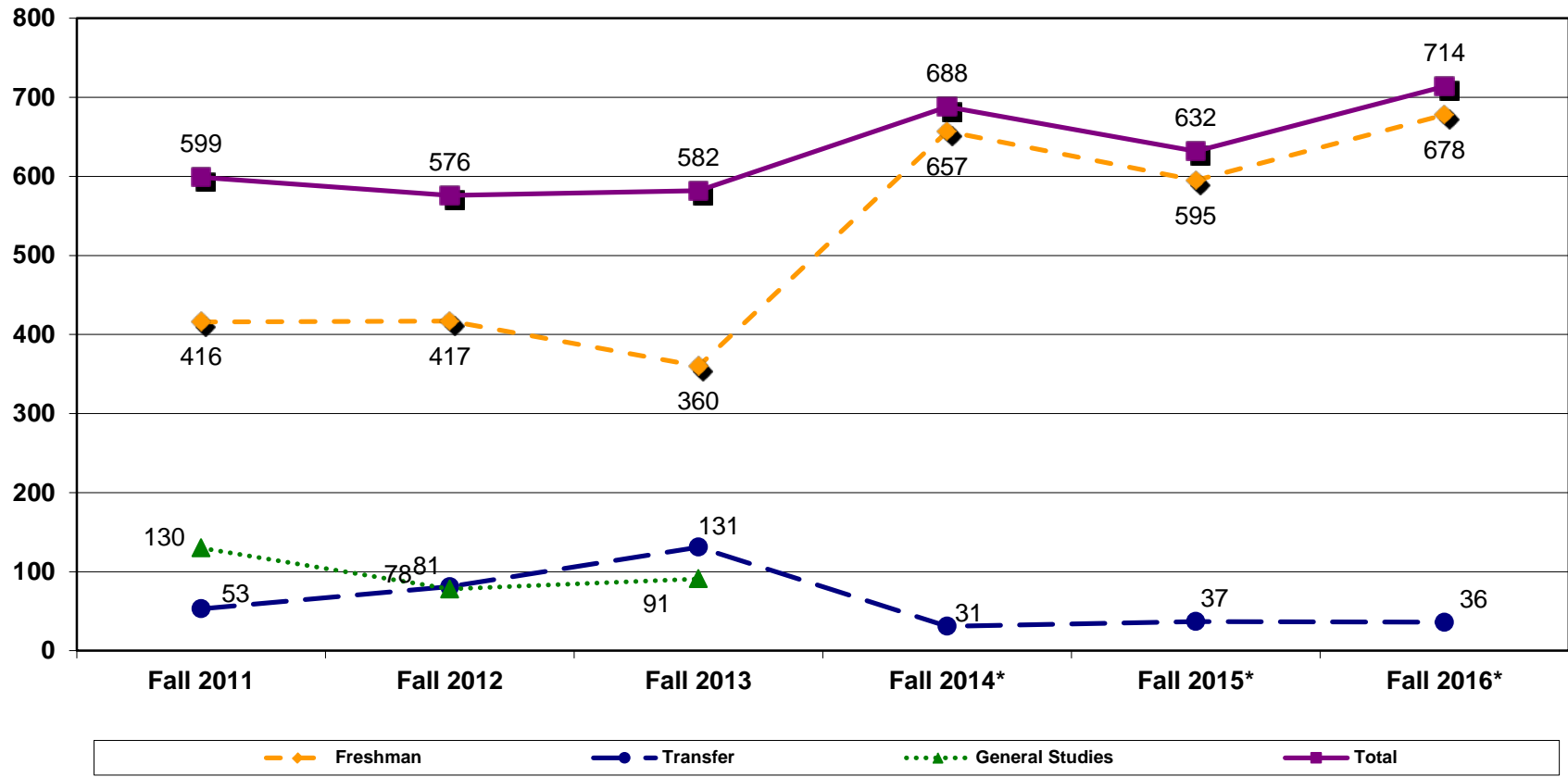

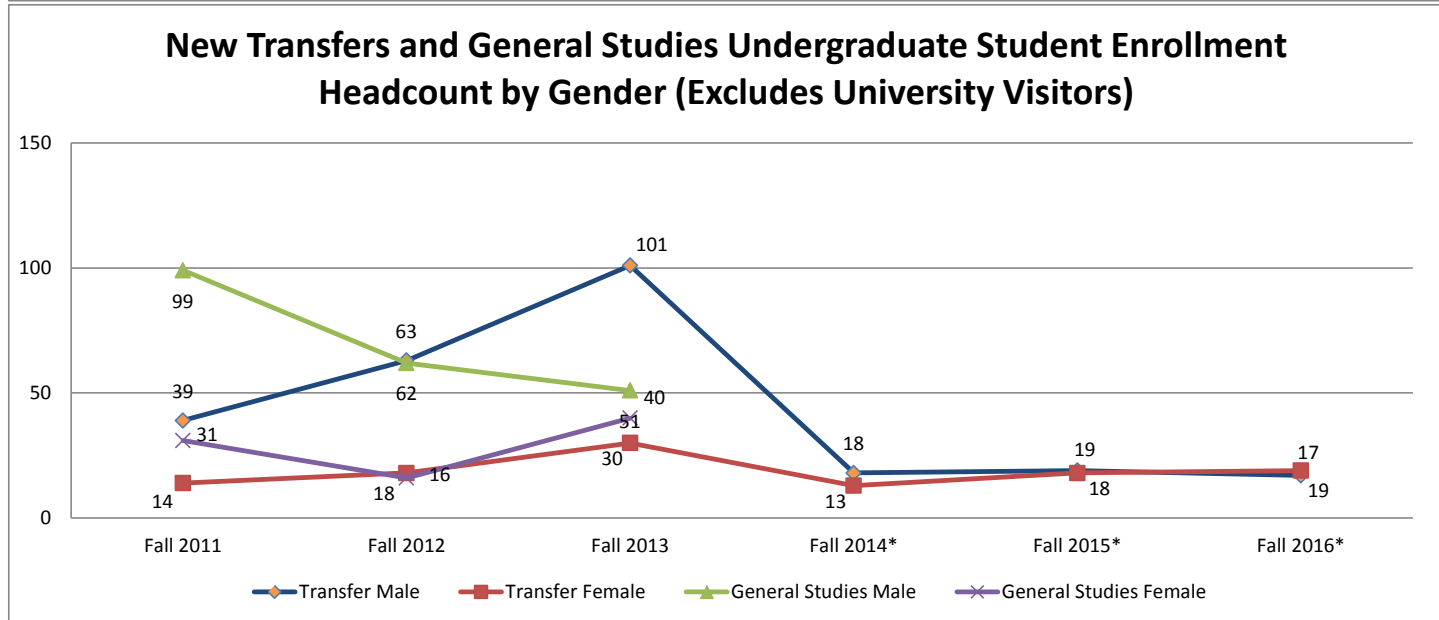
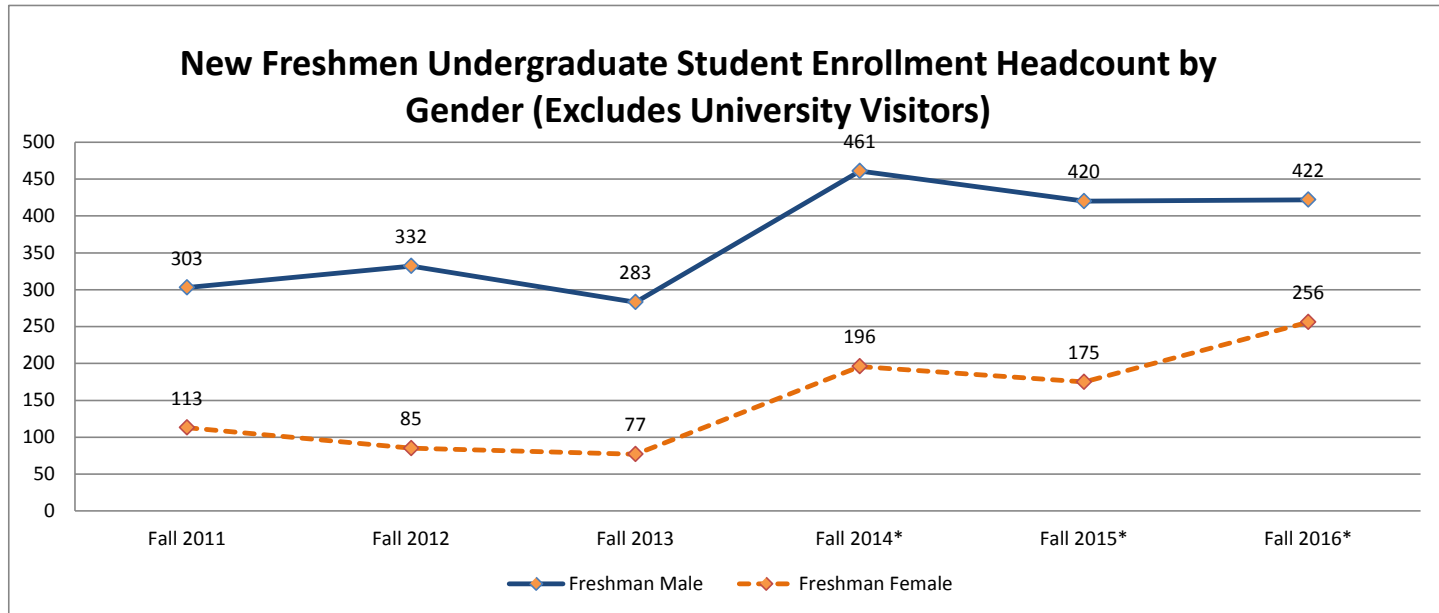


New Undergraduate Student Enrollment Headcount (Excludes University Visitors)



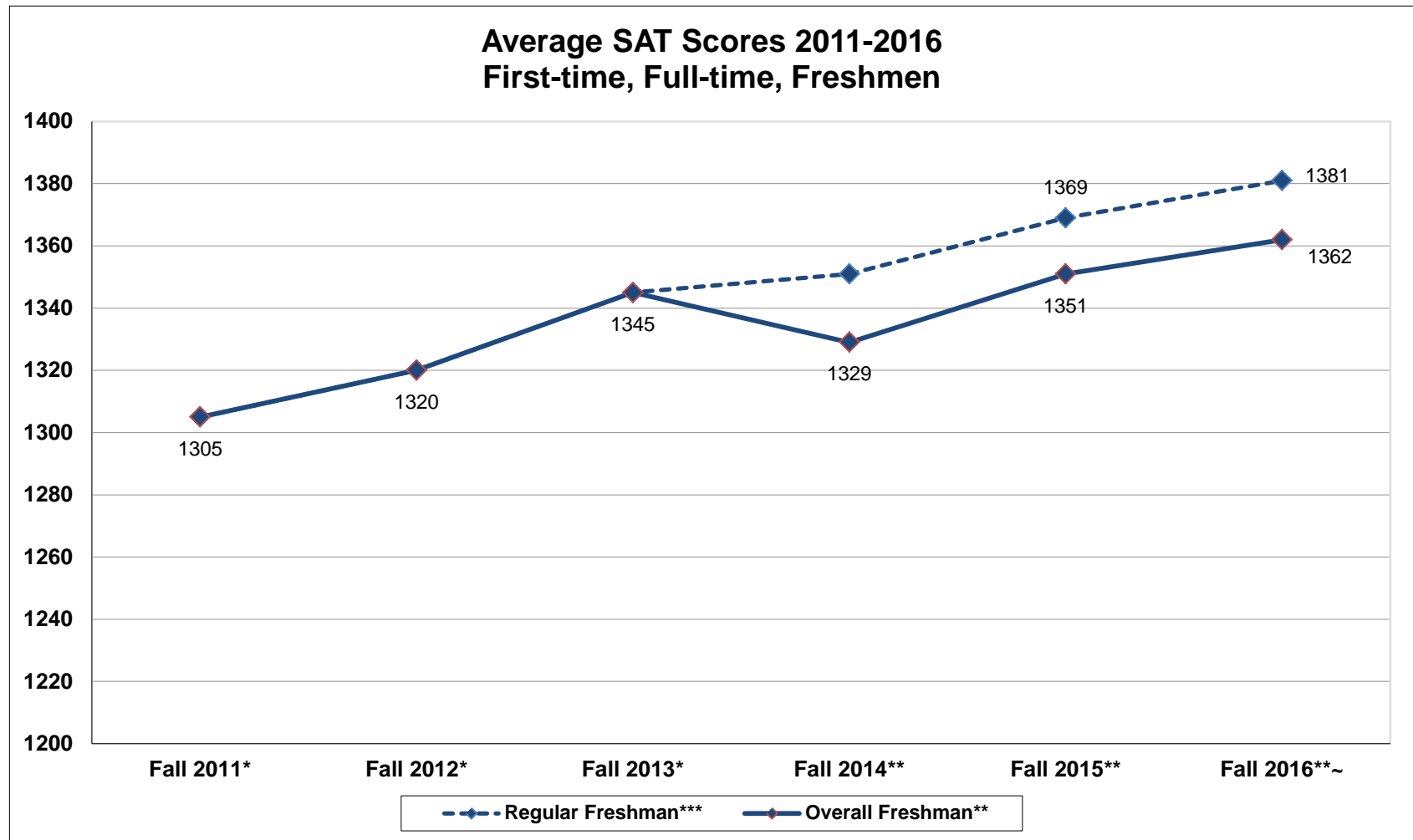

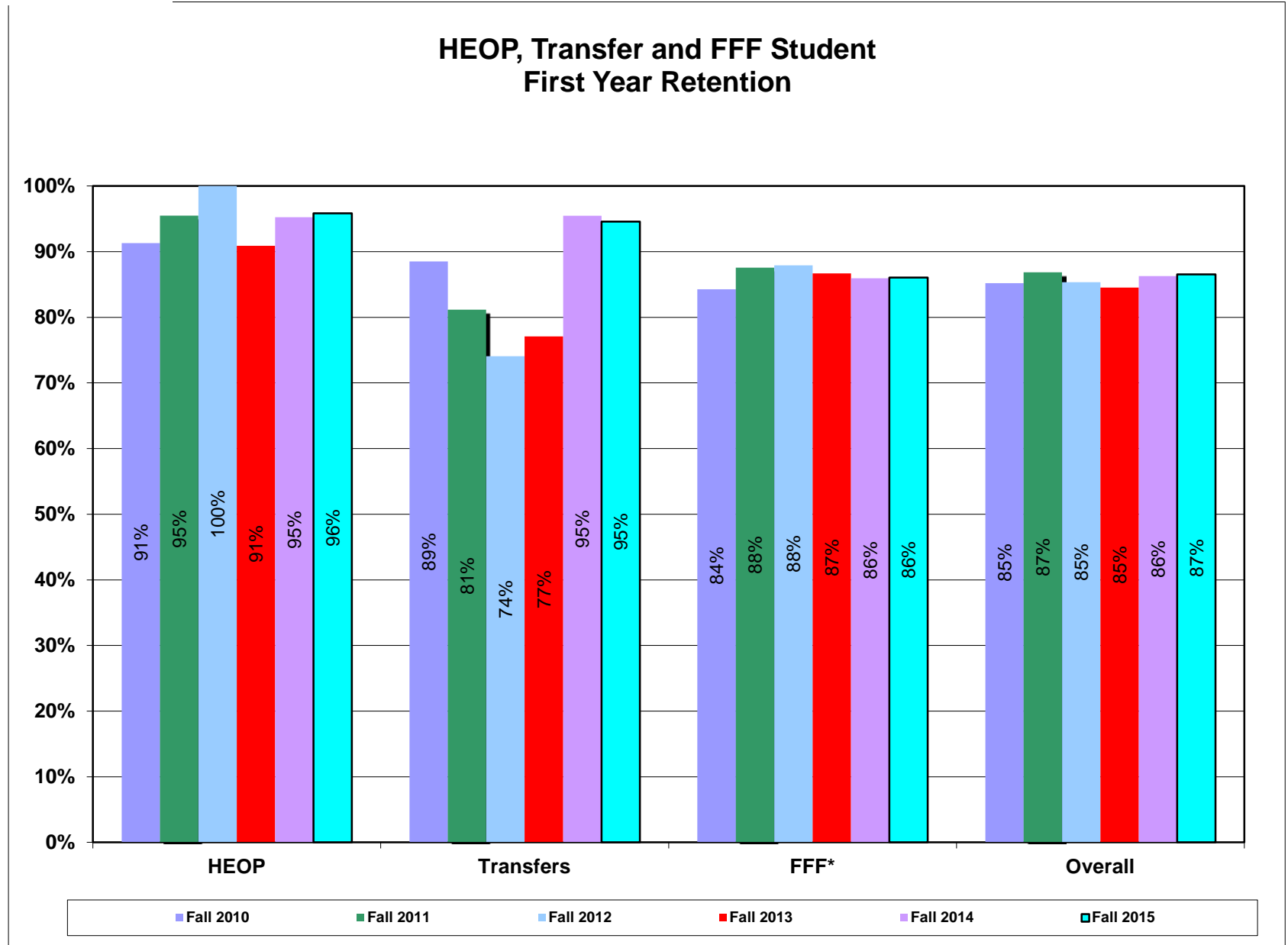

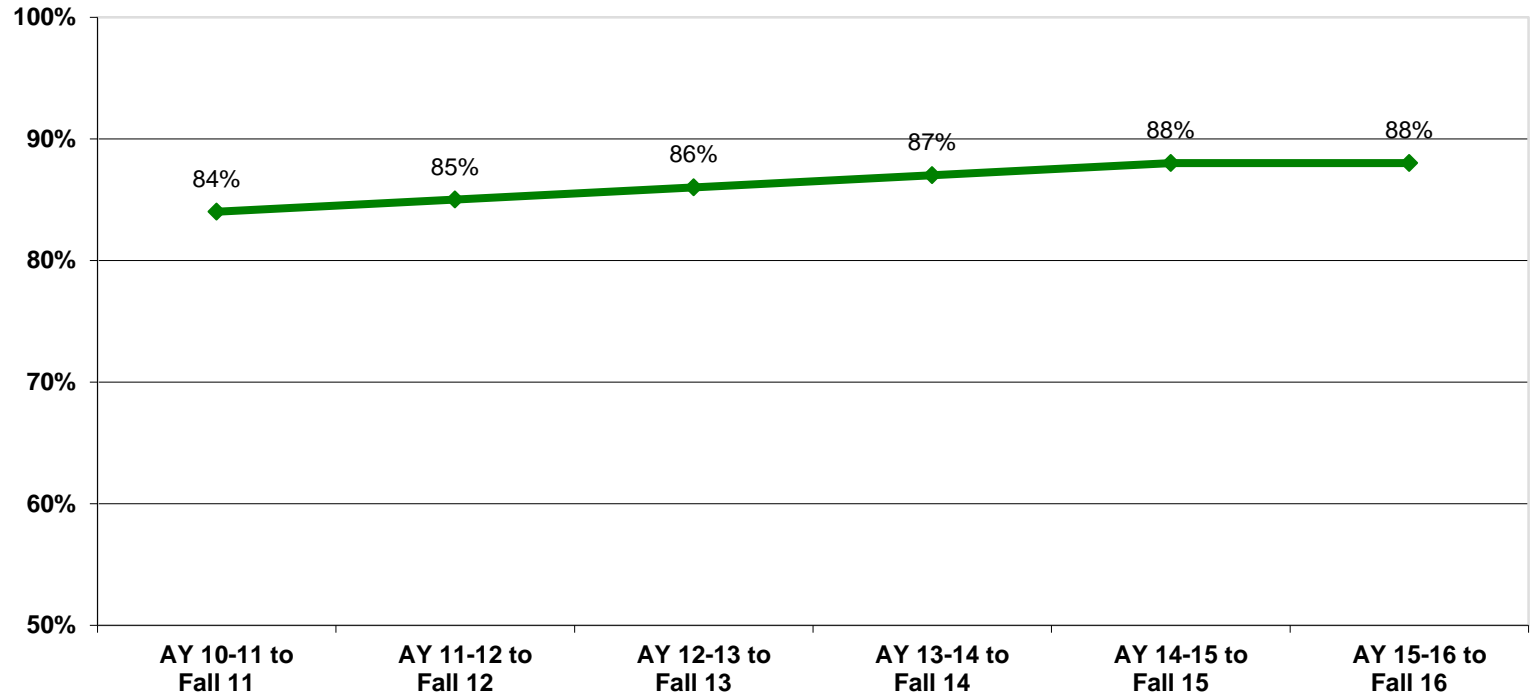

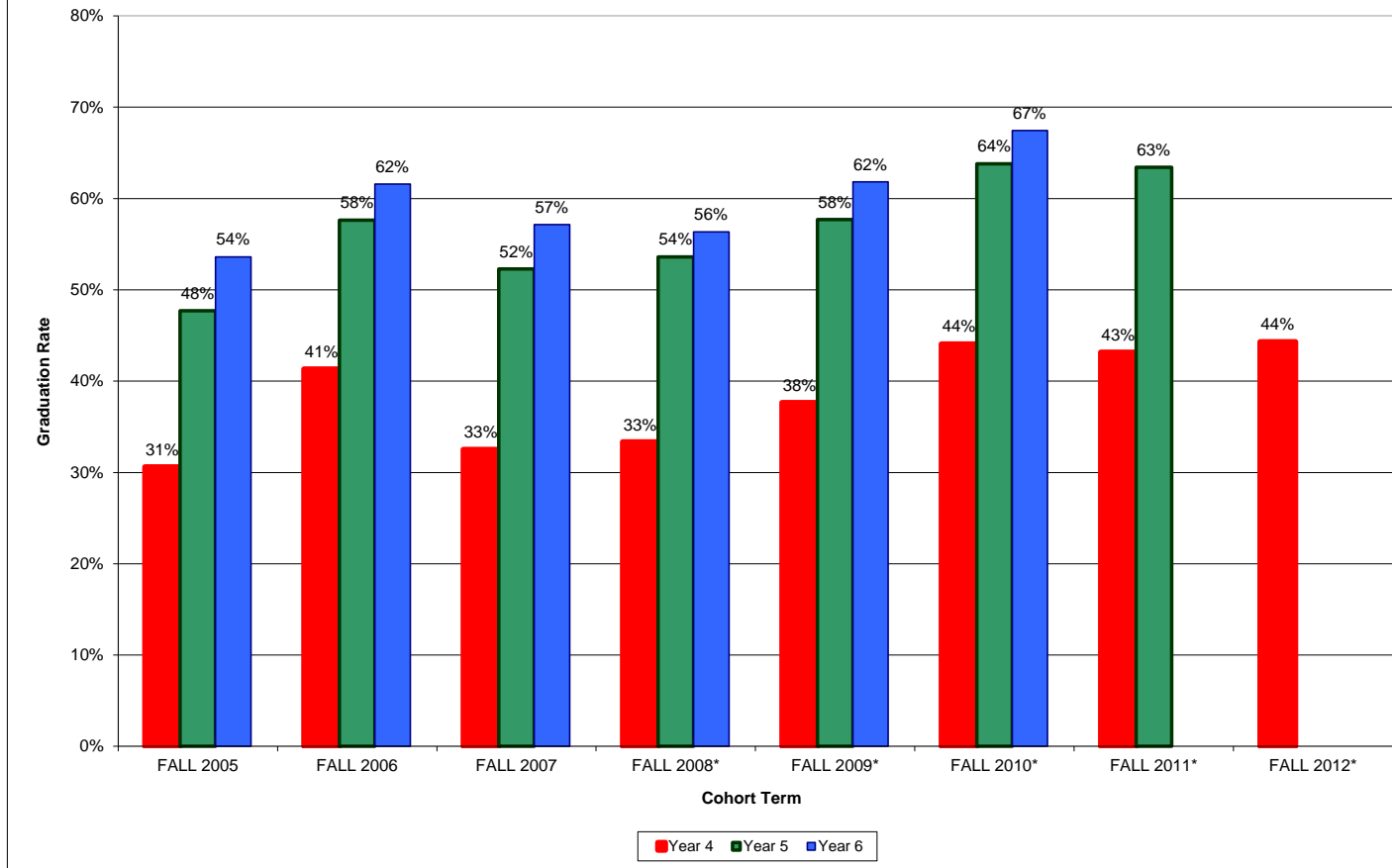
