Welcome NYU Adjunct,

You are teaching at a university where adjuncts like you are protected by a union contract. That means you will earn annual raises, have access to health care, and receive other benefits while you work at NYU.

Our members formed our union, ACT-UAW Local 7902, in 2002 in order to advocate on behalf of adjuncts and cultivate a community of shared interests. Although we teach hundreds of subjects in more than a dozen schools, we all want to be treated fairly and with respect.

Adjuncts at NYU must pay dues. Union dues are 1.44 percent of our gross wages and only collected when we're teaching; there is a one-time \$50 initiation fee. Please fill out the membership card and return it to the union by email or post in order to join the union and have your dues and initiation fee automatically deducted from your paycheck. As a member of our union, you will have a voice in our local and in approving future contracts.

This past spring we were confronted with the COVID-19 pandemic, which upended our lives and our teaching. In response we engaged the university in a number of conversations to make sure our members are not overlooked. Our contract is sturdy. Looking ahead, our union is more important than ever.
